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MOP-L users are mostly engaged in:

- O HIGH-RISK BEHAVIOURS,
- o Personal disorganization,
- O PHYSICAL IMPAIRMENT OR DISEASE,
- PSYCHIATRIC DISEASE,
- PSYCHOLOGICAL VULNERABILITY,
- o SOCIAL EXCLUSION.

MOP-L is frequented by approximately

1200 heroin/polydrug users

on a daily basis

PWID ±20%

Homeless ±15%

HIV ± 15%

HCV ±68%

HIV+HCV ±14%

TB ± 1%

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To Reach opioid drug users who do not access conventional drug addiction treatment centres/other health and social services
