Funded by the U.S. Department of State's Bureau of International Narcotics and Law Enforcement Affairs (INL).



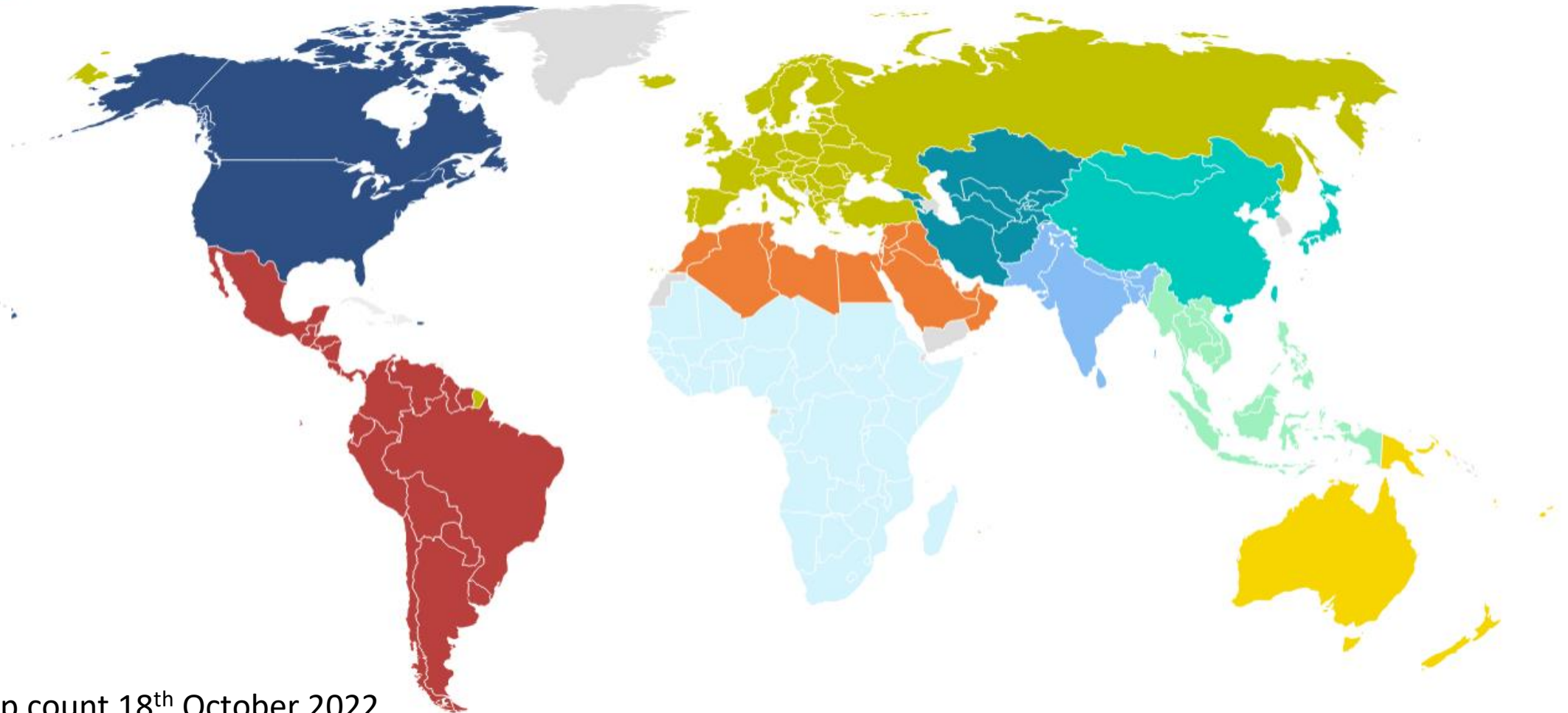

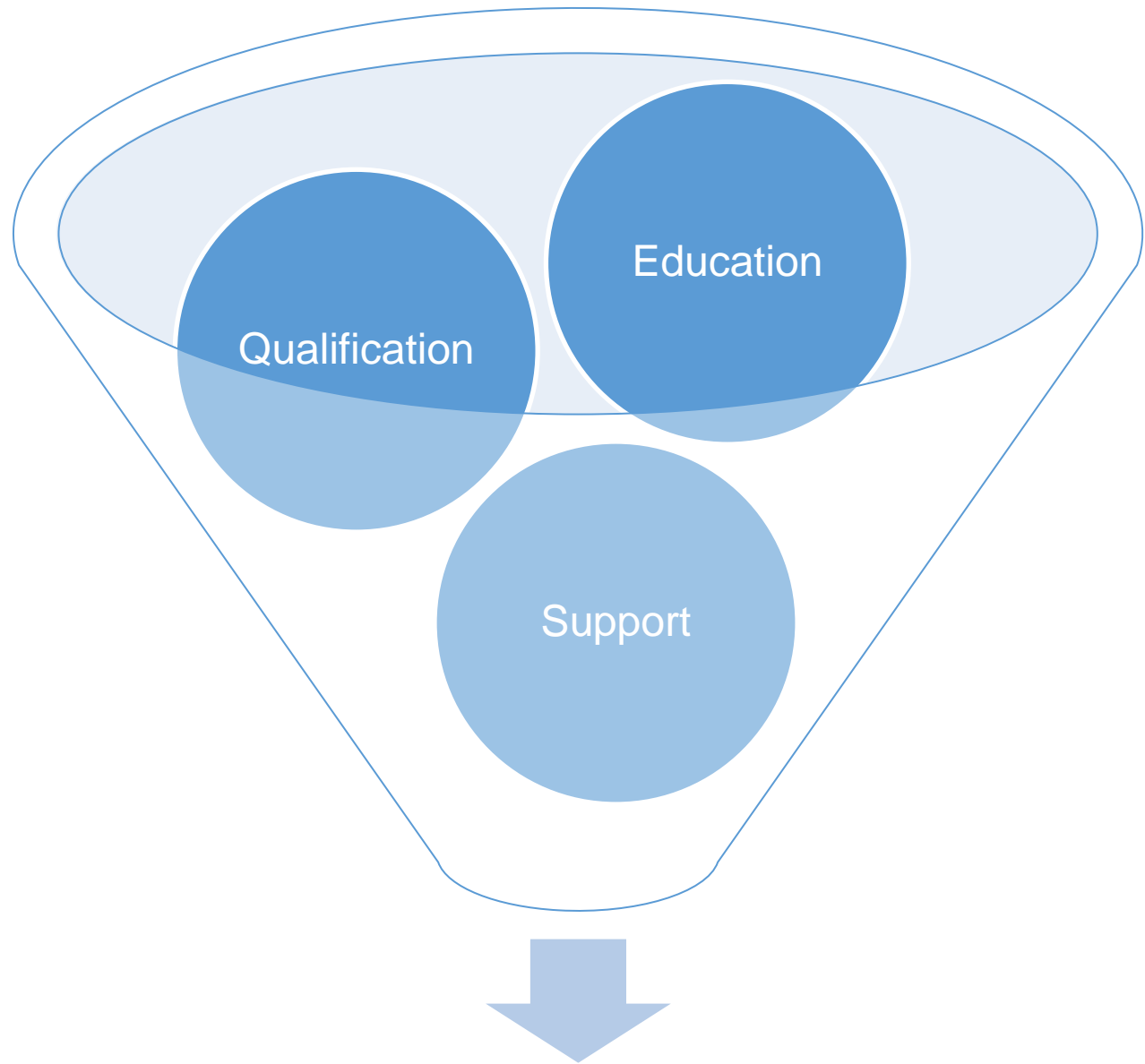

INEP Plus – Facilitation

Facilitation

- Trained 40 facilitators from 20 ISSUP National Chapters to provide a facilitator-led version of INEP around the world
- Potential to reach 300+ “beginners” in prevention
- Feedback for review and improvement and development

- Facilitation Course for 13 new countries and 26 new Facilitators

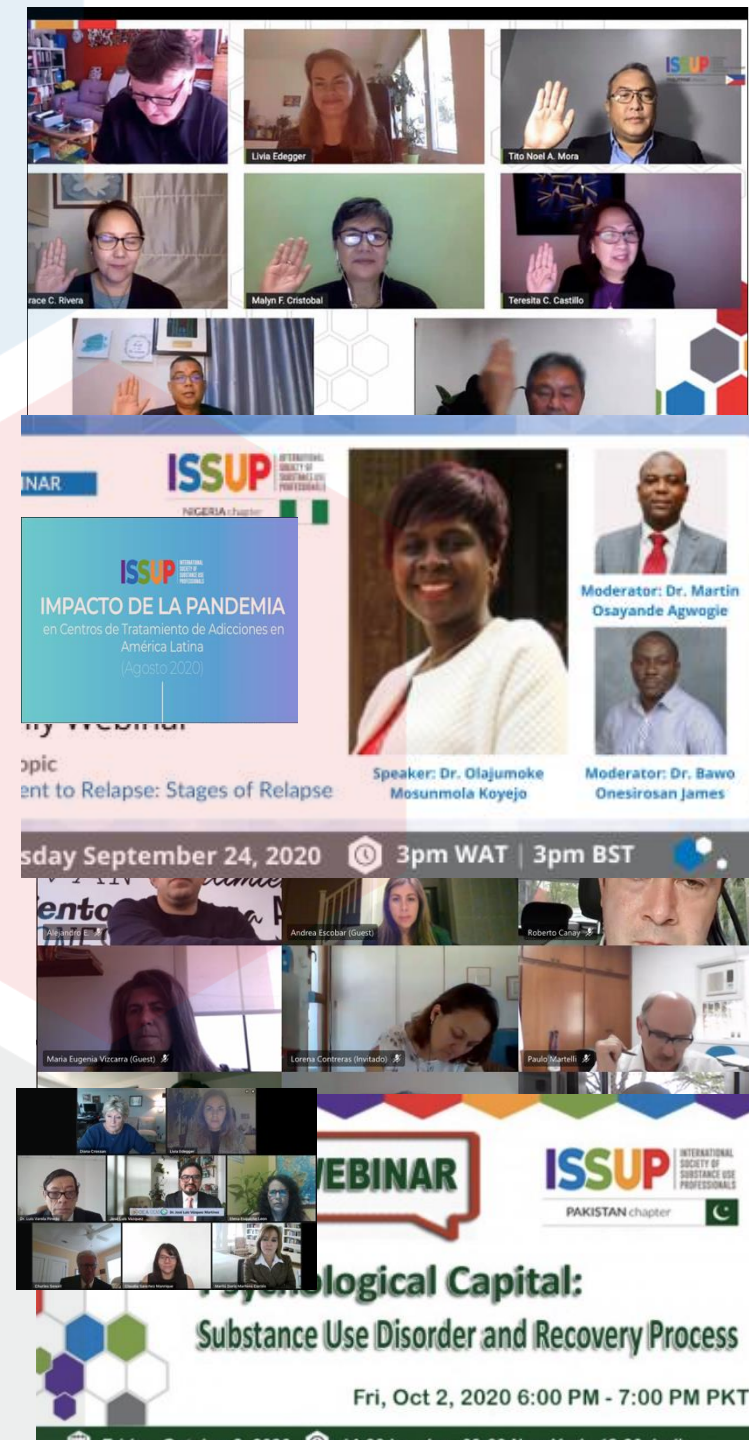
