

How to get to the venue from Lisbon airport

- > [Lisbon international airport](#) lies 7km to the north of the city centre, with direct Metro (underground) access and ample public transport options.

By car

- > **For those driving to the venue**, the CCL has two car parks, with a total capacity of 1 100 spaces. These car parks adapt their business hours to the events and there are several payment options. There is an hourly rate and a daily rate for congress participants and exhibitors, with no entry or exit restrictions. There are additional car parks in the vicinity of the CCL. By taxi

- > Transfer from the airport to the venue by taxi takes approximately 20 minutes, depending on the traffic. Taxis are available in front of the airport building. The estimated travel cost from the airport to the venue should be under EUR 20, assuming daytime travel under regular traffic conditions.

- > Other transport options available via mobile apps (e.g. Uber) are also available in Lisbon.

By public transport

Bus

- > You can reach the city centre by taking one of the buses which leaves Lisbon airport. There is no direct bus to the #LxAddictions22 venue and the trip takes about an hour.

- > The following are alternative bus routes you can take from **Cais do Sodré** to the conference venue:

Metro

- > You can also take the Metro (underground) to arrive at Cais do Sodré from the airport building. Take the red line to Alameda station and then change to the green line running to Cais do Sodré (end of the line). From here, several buses and a tram go to the conference venue (see above).

How to get to the venue from Oriente train station

- > If you are arriving at the Oriente train station, take the Metro (red line) to Alameda and then change to the green line running to Cais do Sodré. From here, several buses and a tram go to the venue (see above).

Lisbon public transport

Carris/Metro card

The same card is valid for both modes of transport. To get your card and load prepaid tickets onto it, go to any Carris network sales point or Metro ticket vending machine. Ticket validation is mandatory, available at the entrance of vehicles and stations.


- > Lisbon Metro is modern, reliable and the quickest way to travel around the capital.
- > There are four lines, covering 46 km of track and served by 55 stations.
- > The Metro is open from 6.30 am to 1.00 am and trains usually run every six to nine minutes.

- > Carris is a public transport company with urban surface vehicles that operates in the whole Lisbon metropolitan area.
- > Carris transports are open from 4.00 am to 1.00 am, depending on the vehicle and route.
